WHEREAS, I, W. G. Surrine, of the County and State aforesaid did heretofore convey a certain lot of land on Manly Street to George Brownlee by deed dated May 14, 1914, and which is recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County in Book 29 at page 23; and

WHEREAS, I did convey unto Cora E. Mason a lot of land lying to the South of and adjoining the lot so conveyed to Brownlee, the deed to the said Cora E. Mason being dated September 3, 1915, and being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County in Book 29, at page 64; and

WHEREAS, I, the said W. GL Surrine am still the owner of the lot of land fronting on Manly Street and lying North of the lot conveyed to George Brownlee; and

WHEREAS, it has been agreed that the conditions and restrictions contained in the said deeds made by me to the said George Brownlee and Cora E. Mason, respectively, shall be abrogated: as to the three lots:
