Whereas, Cedar Falls Light & Power Company did on November 1st, 1912, execute certain bonds aggregating \$25,000.00, and to secure the same did execute a mortgage covering certain lands fully described in said mortgage unto Frank Hammond, as Trustee, (he being dead W.C. Beacham was appointed in his stead),

And, Whereas, the holders of said bonds have authorized the said Trustee to execute a release of said mortgage on such portions of the mortgaged premises as may from time to time be sold,

Now, Therefore, I, W.C. Beacham, as Trustee, in pursuance of the power vested in me by said bond holders, (a copy of which is affixed to the mortgage of record in the Register's office), and in compliance with said power have released and do hereby release and discharge from the lien of said mortgage the tract of land described in the within deed from said Power Company to W.A. Hopkins, by deed dated December 30th, 1916.
