Whereas on or about the 14th day of December 1897, Henry R. Farrow and others conveyed to J.E. and J.T. Farrow certain real estate situate in the County and State aforesaid consisting of One hundred thirteen (113) acres, more or less, by deed recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book DDD, at page 298; a portion of said tract of land was by numerous conveyances conveyed to T.I. Dill and his wife, Lizzie R. Dill, Lee Farrow, who are now the owners and holders thereof. That the tract of land which the said T.I. Dill and Lizzie R. Dill now own contains forty-two and one-half (42- $\frac{1}{2}$) acres, more or less, and being the same conveyed by Mrs.- M.C. Farrow to Eddie A. Farrow and Lizzie R. Farrow by deed dated Feb. 15, 1911, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 17, at page 124.

Now it was the purpose and intent of the parties to the deed from H.R. Farrow, et-al. to J.E. Farrow et-al, that all dowers thereto should be property renounced, but said renunciation of dowers now having been made in accordance with the provisions of the State of South Carolina it is the purpose of this instrument to so renounce.

Wherefore I, Jas. M. Richardson, Notary Public for South Carolina, do hereby certify unto all whom it may concern that Mrs. E.H. Farrow and Mrs. E.C. Farrow, wives of the aforesaid H.R. Farrow and Perry Farrow, did this day appear before me and upon being privately and separately examined by me did each declare that she does freely and voluntarily and without any compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, release, renounce, and forever relinquish unto T.I. Dill and Mrs.- Lizzie Dill and their heirs and assigns, all our interest and estate and also all our Dower rights and claim in or to all and singular the premises above mentioned as now being owned and possessed by the said T.I. Dill and Mrs. Lizzie Dill.
