Received from Postal Telegraph
 Cable Co. Twenty two Haezons (\$2200) in
 consideration of which I hereby grant unto to
 said Company, its successors and assigns
 the right to construct and maintain its
 lines of telegraph, including the necessary
 poles and fixtures, over the property
 which I own, or in which I have any
 interest, in the Township of Oak Lawn
 County of Greenville and State of South
 Carolina and along the roads, streets &
 highways adjoining the said property, with
 the right to trim all trees necessary
 to keep the wires cleared at least eight feet
 inches to set necessary guy and brace poles
 and to attach to trees the necessary guy
 wires. Line to be built not to exceed 4 feet
 from road lines. Any damage done to
 growing crops to be paid for at market
 value.
