Tannahill, T.E. Green, O.L. Miller, T.M. Groce & W.R. Groce for use of the United States as a camp for training troops, or other military purposes, for the term of one year from January 1, 1918, at the annual rental of Three hundred & twenty-five & no/100 Dollars per/per with the yearly option and privilege of four successive annual renewals. The government may remove all houses, pipes, pole lines and all fixtures of every kind whatsoever which it places on the premises. In case the cottage on Green Ave on the above described tract is destroyed and paid for by the government, the above rental is to be reduced from \$325.00 to \$250.00, said reduction of rental to take place at time of destruction of said house.
