Line to be built along road any damage done to growing crops to be paid for at market value, one tree to be topped, line to be built on east side of Augusta road.  
All poles to be set within 3 feet of road line.

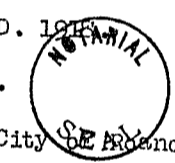
