Wesleyan Methodist Camp Meeting Association (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Rev. J.R. George, Rev. S.I. Keeler, Rev. W.D. Correll, Rev. R.C. Kendrick, and Rev. G.W. Davis as Trustees of the S.C.
