A.L. Henderson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said A.L. Henderson, All the following two lots or parcels of land in Ward One of Greenville City, said State and County.

Lot No. 1: All that lot fronting fifty-two (52) feet on the south side of Hampton Avenue, and being the same lot of land conveyed by J.H. Dean to A.L. Henderson on December 4, 1906. Lot No. 2: All that lot or parcel of land fronting sixty (60) feet, more or less, on the north side of John Street, in the City of Greenville, and being the same lot of land conveyed to A.L. Henderson by the Methodist Prodistant Church on April 13, 1908 and being the same two lots of land conveyed to me by A.L. Henderson on June 9, 1909 by deed duly recorded in the Register of Mesme Conveyance office for said State and County in Vol. 4, page 430, reference to same being hereby craved.
