is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the
said J.L. Locke, All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the south
side of Earle Street, in the City of Greenville, between Wilton and Robinson Streets, and
known as lot "L" of the subdivision of the property of the Mountain City Land and Improvement
Company, as shown on map No. 5 and recorded on page 542 in Vol. VV, in the office of the
R.M.C. for Greenville Co., said lot having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning
at the corner of lot "K" and running thence along Earle Street S. 84-1/2 E. 54-1/3 feet to a
