KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *I. W. A. Chandler*, of Greenville, City
in consideration of the sum of *Five Thousand (\$5,000)* DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
Kate S. O'Neal (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said *Kate S. O'Neal*,

all that lot or parcel of land in said County and State in
ward 2 of the city of Greenville, fronting on the North side of
East Stone Avenue, fifty-four and one-half (54 1/2) feet and running
back by parallel lines, two hundred, six and one-half (206 1/2) feet;
and being known as lot No. 23 of the Plat recorded in the Office of
Registers Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Vol. 100, at
page 544 and being the same lot conveyed to me by Sarah L.
McSwain March 22, 1913; Deed recorded in said Register's Office
