is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Mrs. Floride Rhodes, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, in the State County aforesaid, on the North side of the Chick Spring Road, and having the following courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the Chick Spring Road, and running thence S. 80 E. 3. 16 chs. to an iron pin in the said Road; thence N. 1 W. 5. 00 chs. to an iron pin in a field; thence N. 80 W. 3. 16 chs. to an iron pin; thence S. 16 E. 5. 00 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing One and 58/100 acres, more or less, and bounded on the South by the Chick Spring Road, on the North, East, and West by lands of S.
