Shockley, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Florence D. Shockley, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, known as Richland subdivision, being lots No 4, 5, 6 and 7, having a frontage on Church Street of 20 feet each; Beginning at the corner of a 20 foot street along the Beattie Line and Church Street, running along the street in the Beattie line 100 feet to a point, thence south east, parallel with Church Street 200 feet to a pine, thence 5, 40° 48', 150 feet to Church Street, thence along Church Street N. 50° E. 200 feet to the beginning corner, a shorton on flats, thus being the same lot of land purveyed to me, the said J. L. Green by the said Mrs. Florence D.
