is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

L. C. Jones, his heirs and assigns:  
all that certain lot of land situate on the west side of  
Manly Street in the City and County of Greenville, and beginning  
at a point on said Street at the South-East corner of the plot of M. J.  
Nemov, and runs thence S. 76 W. one hundred and twenty-two feet (122' 6")  
and six inches to an iron pin at the head of an alley leading from another  
alley, thence S. 15 1/2 E. fifty-nine feet and (59' 7") seven inches, thence N.  
76 E. one hundred and twenty-two feet and (122' 6") six inches to Manly Street,  
thence with said street N. 15 1/4 W. fifty-nine feet and (59' 7") seven inches to
