(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Lula Williams, her heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land containing Two (2) acres, more or less, situate and being in Grove Township, in the State and County aforesaid, bounded by lands of J.T. Roe, Nancy Williams, myself and others, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on Roe's corner; thence N. 82-3/4 W. 3.95 to a stone X3; thence N. 18-3/4 E. 6.45 to a stake X3; thence S. 74-1/2 E. 1.60 to a stake X3; thence S. 18-3/4 W. 2.96 to a stone X3; thence S. 72-1/4 E. 3.25 to a stone X3; thence S. 18-3/4 W. 2.58 to the beginning corner, the same being a part of the lot of land conveyed to me by deed from W.A.
