KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, G.F. Hinkle in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of ten dollars and other good and valuable considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.D. Bridges

J.D. Bridges, All that certain lot of land, situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the North side of the Cedar Lane Road, known as Lot #5, on plat made by F.G. Rogers: Beginning at a stake on said road, 80 feet from the Northwest corner of said road and Monroe Street; thence with said road N. 39 W. 60 feet; thence N. 51 E. 152 feet; thence S. 34 E. 32 feet; thence S. 45 W. 70 feet; thence S. 59 E. 20 feet; thence S. 47 1/2 W. 90 feet to the beginning and being the same lot of land conveyed to me, the said G.F.
