I, Mary L. Paok, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Minnie L. West

is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Minnie L. West, her heirs and assigns, All that lot or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known as lot Number 61, on a plat made by J.E. Sirrine of the Morgan Hill Annex, said plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in plat book "A", at pages 68 and 69, said lot being situate on new cut road, known as Bramlett Road, and fronting on said road sixty feet (60), running back parallel with the line of lots number 60 and 62, two hundred feet (200) as shown by plat, and containing twelve thousand square feet, this being one of the lots conveyed to me by L.A. Greene by deed dated the 4th day of June 1913 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Volume 36, page 68.
