 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W.M. Ridgeway, his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate,
 lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Dunklin Township, and
 having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3X11M in the Public Road
 and running thence N. 67-15 E. 21.50 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 65 E. 11.50 to a stone 3XOM in
 Public Road; thence S. 3 E. 3.00 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 65 E. 6.42 to a stone 3XOM; thence S.
 3 W. 13.36 to a stone 3XOM; thence S. 65 W. 25.80 to a stone 3Xom in road; thence N. 45 W. 8.00
