KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. Traynham of Greenville County

In the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Sixteen hundred and fifty & no/100 (\$1650.00) DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. M. Ridgeway (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. M. Ridgeway, his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Dunklin Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3X1M in the Public Road and running thence N. 67-15 E. 21.30 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 65 E. 11.50 to a stone 3XOM in Public Road; thence S. 3 E. 3.00 to a stone 3XOM; thence N. 65 E. 6.42 to a stone 3XOM; thence S. 3 W. 13.36 to a stone 3XOM; thence S. 65 W. 25.80 to a stone 3XOM in road; thence N. 45 W. 8.00 to an iron stake 3XNM in the road; thence N. 49 W. 8.50 to the beginning corner, and containing 45-8/10 acres, more or less. - Less ten (10) acres, sold and conveyed therefrom by W. M. Woods, et-al. by deed dated 16th, day of Nov. 1911, and recorded in Vol. #17 of deeds, at page 339; thus leaving 35-8/10 acres, more or less which is conveyed by this deed.
