KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L. A. Greene,

in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of  
Five Dollars, exchange of property and other valuable consideration  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Mary L. Pack

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mary L. Pack, her heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on Epps Street, in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, containing one (1) acre, more or less, and bounded by lands now or formerly owned by Sarah Brockman, George Nichols, Mennie Walker and Mrs. A. T. Munn, said lands being situate just outside of the city limits of Greenville, and having situate thereon four (4) negro dwelling houses, being the same land conveyed to me by F. F. Beattie by deed dated the 28th day of January 1910, deed recorded in Vol. 5 at page 566, in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

Also all that lot or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known as lot No. 61 on a plat made by J. E. Squire, of the Morgan Hill Annex, said plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book A, at page 68 and 69 said lot being situate on new cut road, known as Bramlett road, and fronting on said road sixty feet (60'), running back parallel with the line of lots Nos. 60 and 62, two hundred feet (200') as shown on said plat, and containing twelve thousand square feet, this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. M. Fortner by deed dated the 6th day of September, 1910, deed recorded in Vol. 5 at page 307.

Also all those two certain lots of land, with houses thereon, situate in the County and State aforesaid, near Monaghan Mills, better known as New Hope, fronting on Fortner Street and being known as lots Nos. 12 and 13 on a plat recorded in R. M. C. office in Plat Book A, at page 409.

Also all that lot, with house thereon, situate in said County and State near Woodside Cotton Mill, about two miles from the city of Greenville, better known as Summit View, being known as lot No. 10, on Creek Street, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book A, at page 75, Block E.

Also one vacant lot situate in said County and State near Monaghan Mills, better known as New Hope, and being known as lot No. 31, on plat recorded in Plat Book A, at page 409; said lot being situate on corner of Boatner Street and Jones Alley.

The last above described four lots of land were conveyed to me by J. M. Fortner, by deeds dated the 14th day of December 1910; deed recorded in Vol. 9, at pages 461 and 463.
