KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That He, Masquet Holcombe, Mary Moore, (nee Gosnell) Victoria Seay (nee Gosnell) Minnie, (nee Gosnell) Mattie Evans (nee Gosnell) and George Gosnell

in the State aforesaid for and These Hundred in consideration of the sum of DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Alfred W. Gentry

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Alfred W. Gentry, all that tract, piece and parcel of land situated and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid and on Waters of South Pacolet River, adjoining lands of J. J. Gosnell, Frances Lindsey and others, being a part of the Levi Ward land. Beginning at a Poplar on said Ward's line at a branch and running S. 68 E. 5 chains to a Pine; thence S. 43 E. 20 chains to a Pine; thence S. 10 E. 10-1/2 chains to a Red Oak on Ward's line thence with said Ward's line S. 60 W. 26 chains to a chestnut Oak; thence N. 45 W. 9 chains to a Forked Red Oak; thence N. 80 W. 32 chs. to a Poplar on a branch, the beginning corner, containing sixty acres, more or less.
