KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, W. D. Robertson of Greenville  
County

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

One Dollar and the Love and affection I have for my wife, Mollie Robertson me DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by my said wife Mollie Robertson

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mollie Robertson the following real estate, to-wit:

Tract No. 1- Situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, containing two hundred and seventy-five acres, more or less, bounded by lands of M.K. Robertson and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by my father W.D. Robertson, by his deed bearing date 10th, day of September 1904, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, Vol. N.N.N., page 255, which said deed is here referred to for a fuller description of said lands, the same being described therein by metes and bounds.

Tract No. 2- All that piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, on the head waters of Tyger River, on both sides of the State Road, adjoining lands of E.M. Blythe and others, containing three hundred and four acres, more or less, known as the Wm. Fuller Tract.

Tract No. 3- All that piece, parcel and tract of land adjoining the tract above described containing  $5\frac{1}{3}$  acres, more or less, being the tract of land conveyed to W.D. Robertson by A.A. Stuart by his deed bearing date 3rd, Oct. 1878 & by W.D. Robertson conveyed to me.

Tract No. 4- All that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid containing  $9\frac{1}{2}$  acres, more or less, being the same tract of land conveyed to W.D. Robertson by Geo. J. Southern by his deed bearing date 11th, day Feby. 1889, and by the said W.D.-Robertson conveyed to me.

The three tracts of land last above mentioned were all included in a deed thereof made by my father W.D. Robertson to me, bearing date November 1911, and recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County Vol. 16, page 26, and here referred to as part of this conveyance.
