(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

P. T. Hayne, R. D. Peace, R. E. Gees, E. M. Lirrine, Earl Wilson and Eug B. Foster as Trustees of Greenville School District No. 17, full & complete piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, same being a portion of Boyce's addition to Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat hereof in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, State of South Carolina in plat book of page 179 to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on West side Bayce Ave. joint corners of lots nos. 6 and 8 thence S. 76° 45' W. along joint line of said lots, two hundred and five feet to an iron pin joint corners of lots nos. 4 and 6, thence S. 15° 0' E. along joint line of lots nos. 5, 7 and 8 sixty-four feet, four inches to an iron pin joint corners of lots nos. 7 and 8 and Cogswell's lot, thence in an easterly direction along joint line of Cogswell's and Woodfield's lots two hundred and seven feet to an iron pin on Bayce Ave. thence N. 15° 0' W. along Bayce Ave. fifty-one feet seven inches to an iron pin at the beginning corner, survey of J.
