DEED TO W. D. Parrish

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. L. Hower

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

ten Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by

W. D. Parrish

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. D. Parrish, All my undivided one-half interest in and to all that lot of land situate on the east side of main street, between barrier and Stone Avenue in the city and county of Greenville, South Carolina, having a frontage of sixty (60) feet on main street and running back from main street in parallel lines two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less, to an alley, bounded on the north by W. A. Merritt; on the east by lands formerly belonging Ellen J. Arnold, and on the west by main street, on the south by J. Thomas Arnold.

also all that lot or strip of land situate on the east side of north main street, in the city and county of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning on said street at the corner of lot formerly owned by Ellen J. Arnold, and running thence with line of that lot n. 70-1/2 E. two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less, to an alley; thence along the alley towards barrier street, twelve (12) feet; thence in a straight line to main street two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less, to a point on said street twelve (12) feet from the beginning corner; thence with said street twelve (12) feet to the beginning corner.

The two above described lots being the same conveyed to W. P. Childers by Sallie M. Hower, by deed dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 1915, deed recorded in Vol. 28, at Page 600, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville county, and from W. P. Childers to S. D. Skelton by deed dated November 17<sup>th</sup> 1915, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville county in Vol. 38, Page 209, and from S. D. Skelton to W. D. Parrish and J. L. Hower, by deed dated April 16<sup>th</sup> 1917.
