KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, E. H. Heater of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid  
 in consideration of the sum of  
 One hundred (\$100) and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,  
 to me in hand paid  
 at and before the sealing of these presents by J. H. Eskew

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. H. Eskew his heirs and assigns forever:  
 All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated,  
 lying and being in Greenville Township, County  
 and State aforesaid, containing seventy three and  
 one-half ( $73\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres, more or less and bounded  
 as follows to wit: adjoining land of John M. Jones,  
 W. H. Harris and others with the following  
 lines: beginning at a stone in the old road  
 or "Carpenter's line" and running thence N 24 $\frac{3}{4}$   
 E 34.80 to a sweet gum 340m; thence N 59 W 4.50 to a  
 stone 340m; thence S 75 W. 19.45 to stone 34m; thence S 22 $\frac{1}{4}$   
 E. 20.20 to stone 34m on old public road; thence with  
 old road 1503 to beginning corner, and being the same  
 lot of land deeded to Dave Burns by Willis P. Hicks,  
 deed recorded in R. M. L. of Greenville County in  
 Deed Book Vol. 19 page 24 as part of consideration  
 herein expressed. It is understood and agreed that  
 J. H. Eskew assumes and is to pay a note and  
 mortgage given to Willis P. Hicks by Dave Burns,  
 amounting to Thirty-two Hundred and eighty-  
 one & 87/100 (\$3281.84) Dollars with 8% January 1st 1914.  
 This being the same tract of land deeded to  
 me (E. H. Heater) by David Burns, deed dated Jan.  
 1, 1914. Said E. H. Heater reserved one half of rents of
