KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. L. S Honour of the City of Atlanta, State of Georgia,

J. L. S Honour in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by J a Honour

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. a. Honour, all my right, title and interest in and to all that lot of land situate on the Pendleton Road just beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, S.C., and near Brandon Cotton Mills, known as no. 6 Honour's Row, measuring on Pendleton road, beginning at no. 5, 60 feet west to no. 7; thence south two hundred (200) feet to Southern Railway right of way; thence east 60 feet more or less to no. 5; thence north 200 feet more or less to Pendleton road, being the same land conveyed to my mother, Rebecca L. Honour by J. a. Honour, Jr. on 25th day of June, 1913, and recorded in Vol. 23 at page 7 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, reference thereunto being had, my interest in said land being one-sixth undivided interest.

also; my undivided one-sixth interest in and to all that certain tract or parcel of land situate about two miles from the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, known as the Sevon Farm, and bounded as follows; On the north by J. J. Seyle and 4th Street, Woodside Mill Village east by the Piedmont & Northern Line; South by Pendleton road and on the west by J. J.
