ALL that certain strip piece or parcel of land of the seid (Mrs) Alice E. Means, situate, lying and being on either side oflocated common center line of proposed new double track railroad of Atlanta and Charlotte Air Line Railway Company as the same will extend through property of the said Mrs. Means, adjoining the lands of Mrs. A.
