Henry Harris, his heirs and assigns, all of our respective undivided rights, title and interest, being a one eighth each, of, in and to all the lots and parcels of land hereinafter described having the courses dimensions and location as is shown on the plats recorded or to be recorded along with this deed, to wit:

- First: Augusta Street property, plat of same recorded in Plat Book C, at page 261 lots Nos. 35, 6, 16, 23 and 14.
- Second: West Highland property; plat of same recorded in Plat Book C, at pages 258-259, lots Nos. K-3, J-2, H-3, H-2 E-2, C-3, F-1, B, C-2.
- Third: East Highland property: plat of same recorded in Plat Book C at page 146, lots Nos. 22, 69, 37, 75, 65 and 76.

The aforesaid lots being parts of the land as aforesaid, inherited from our mother F.E. Harris, and other lands conveyed to us by our father, J.M. Harris, and five acre Judson Mill tract conveyed to us by the said N. Henry Harris, but does not convey other lands we own in common, which are not described herein.
