Harris, his heirs and assigns, all of our respective undivided rights, title and interest, being a one-eighth each, of, in and to all the lots and parcels of land hereinafter described, having the courses, dimensions and location as is shown on the plat recorded or to be recorded along with this deed, to wit:-

First: Augusta Street property; plat of same recorded in Plat Book c, at page 261; lots Nos 3, 32, 7.

Second: West Highland property; plat of same recorded in Plat Book C, at pages 258-259 lots Nos. (H-1)

Third: East Highland property; plat of same recorded in Plat Book C, at page 146; Lots Nos. 46, 44, 60, 31, 74.
