Werts, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, and being near the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being in that section of the County known as Mickelwood and said lot being off public road, leading from Fairview Road to Mickelwood settlement, said lot having following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at stake on south side of public road at stake at corner of E. E. Stone's lot & running thence in northwesterly direction 25 feet to stake and thence in southwesterly direction along E. E.
