by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Henry Holliday, his heirs and assigns forever all that certain lot of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, near the eastern limits of the City of Greenville, in vicinity of what is known as the lot No 5 of block "C" of Jefferson Heights as shown by plat of record in the office of the P.M.C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book "L", page 34 and 35, and having the following meter and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on the east side of First Avenue; front corner of Lots nos. 4 and 5 and running thence N. 81.40 E. 87 feet 5 inches to a pin, thence S. 0-30 W. 25 feet, 5 inches to a pin; thence S. 81-40 W. 87 feet, 5 inches to a pin on First Avenue; thence with said Avenue, N. 0-30 E. 25 feet, 5 inches to the beginning point, this being the same lot formerly conveyed to Loretta Jackson by W. Hutchings: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the Town of Greer, on Trade Street, having the following metes and bounds; to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on said Trade Street at corner of Thompson Hardware Company's lot and running thence with said street 23 feet to iron pin; thence N 78 E. 100 feet to iron pin; thence at right angles to said street northward 23 feet to Thompson Hardware Company's line; thence along this line S 78 W 100 feet to the beginning corner.
