WHEREAS, J. E. Strange, Maria Miller, Albert Strange, Nora Simmons, Della Collins, Mary Daines, Ollie Strange and Bonnie Bowling

on or about the 26th day of July in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and Seventeen exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Thelma Bowling and Mrs. S. S. Harvin

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 22nd day of November 1917, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$400.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Mrs. Kate

Harvin, her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate, to wit:
all that certain piece or tract of land lying and being in said State and County, Chicks Springs Township, near Chicks Springs and on the public road leading from Green Ville Court House to Chicks Springs, bounded by lands of Alfred Taylor and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on a stone in the edge of said public road running thence South 33 1/8 East 4.15 chains to a stone; thence South 56 7/8 West 2.41 chains to a stone; thence North 33 1/8 West 4.15 chains to a stone on the edge of said public road; thence along said public road North 56 7/8 East 2.41 chains to the beginning corner, containing one acre.
