the following metes and bounds:
Beginning at a point on said street, and
runs thence with said street 83 feet to a
westward line; thence with said line
one hundred and two (102) feet and six (6) inches
to Franklin Mill line; thence with this
line one hundred and one (101) feet to Hallings-
worth line; thence along this line one
hundred and twenty nine (129) feet to the
beginning corner, and is the same
lot of land conveyed to S. B. Green by
R. S. Foster, in deed bearing date made
9th 1915.
