All that lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, in the town of Green, on Hubert Street, having the following meters and bounds: Beginning at a point on said street and runs thence with said Street 83 feet to E. D. Westmoreland's line; thence with his line one hundred two (102) feet and six (6) inches to Franklin Mill line; thence with this line one hundred one (101) feet to Hollingsworth line; thence along this line one hundred twenty nine (129) feet to the beginning corner, and is the same lot of land conveyed to E. D. Green by R. F. Foster in deed bearing date March 9th, 1915.
