estate, to wit: All that certain tract of land in
Greenville County, in Paris Mountain Township, South
Carolina, containing 27 3/4 acres, more or less, bounded
by lands, now or formerly, Henry Allen, T. W. Cole, and
George Lester, represented by a plat made by W. A.
Kuster dated December 18, 1911, and more particularly
described as follows: Beginning at a stone on Henry
Allen's corner and northeast corner of said tract and run-
ning fence 76 3/4 W. 15.50; thence N. 87 3/4 W. 13.00 to a stone
in branch; thence N. 55 E. 5.84; thence N. 14 1/2 E. 3.40 to
beginning corner. Also a small portion of land adjoining
said tract on the north side containing 1 1/2 acres,
bounded by branch and north line of said tract above
described and indicated on said plat by letter 'B'.
