in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by A. J. Staton

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said A. J. Staton his heirs and assigns forever: All that certain piece, parcel and tract of of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the waters of South Tiger River and Camp Creek and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
