Edwards in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Thirty Five Hundred (\$3500) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by A. G. Edwards of Laurens County and State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said A. G. Edwards: All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being in the county and State aforesaid and containing seventy (70) acres, more or less. Beginning at an iron pin on Public Road, Mrs. Hattie Thackston lands and running thence S 54 1/2 E. 17.25 to a stake, thence S 56 E. 1.07 to a P.O. stump, thence N. 53 E. 18.60 to a stone, thence N. 27 1/4 E 38.00 to an iron pin, thence N. 36 1/2 W 1.43 to a stone on North side of road, thence S 52 3/4 W. 58.20 to beginning corner, bounded by lands of myself, F.D. Hunter, Mrs. J. Stewart W.M. Brown, Mrs. Hattie Thackston, Mrs. Josie Godfrey and others, and being the same represented by a plat drawn by S.G. 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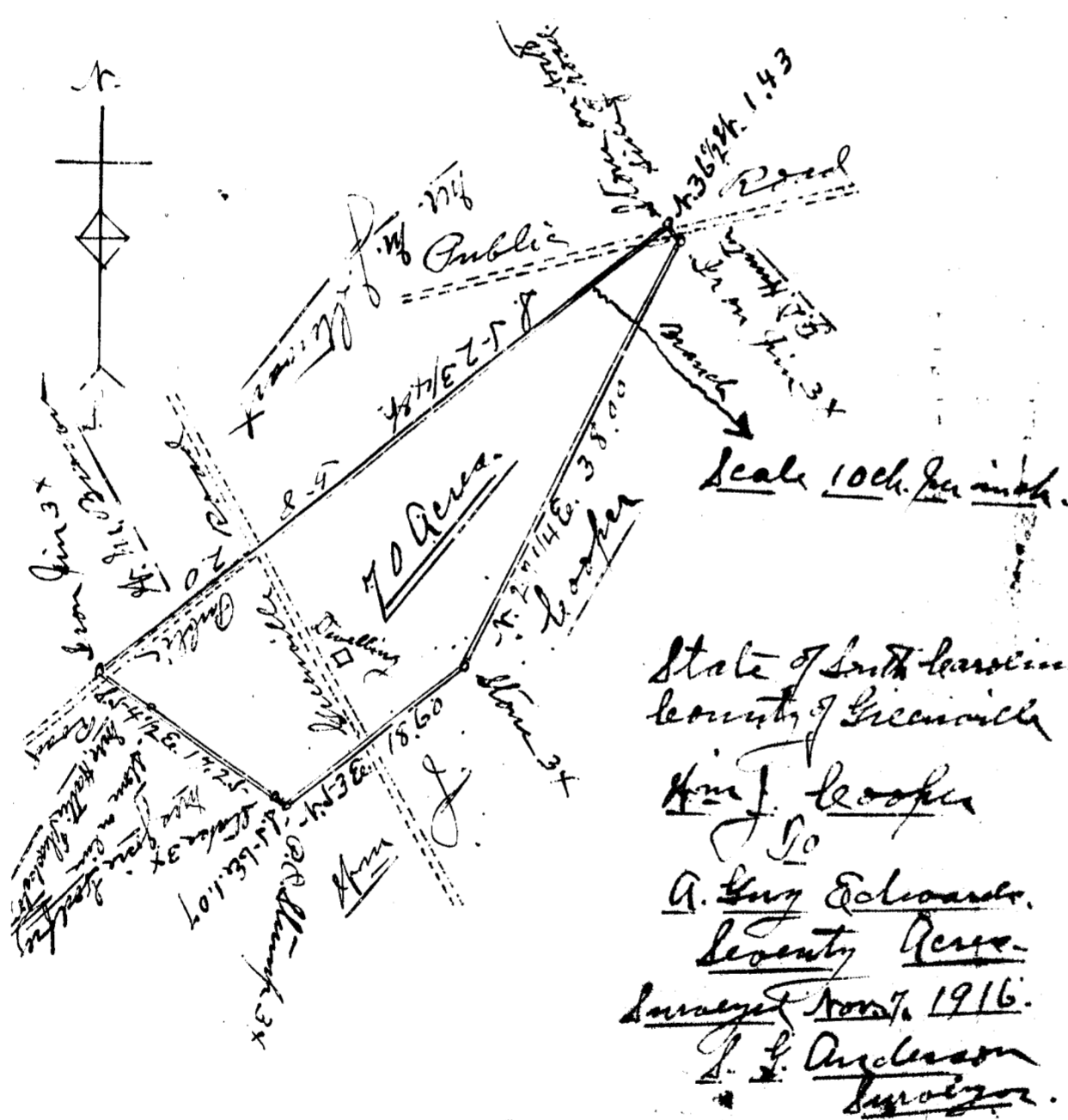

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said George H. Hart. All that piece, parcel, or lot of land situate in the city of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being a portion of the Rowley place and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Lavinia Avenue at joint corners of lots Nos 15 and 16 thence with said Avenue N. 21-45 W. sixty feet to a stake at joint corners of lots Nos 17 and 16; thence with joint lines of said lots S. 76-30 W. one hundred and eighty feet to a stake on Glover Street; thence with said Glover Street, S. 21-45 E. sixty feet to a stake at joint corners of lots nos 15 and 16 thence with joint lines of said lots N. 76-30 E. one hundred and eighty feet to a stake at the beginning corner, and being known as lot No. 16 according to a survey made by W.A.
