(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said R. E. Walden, his heirs and assigns, all of that certain piece of land, and lot of land, situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid about five miles above Greenville City on the east side of the Biscomb road, being a part of a 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre tract of land purchased by me from W. G. Henderson and J. T. Hunt by deed dated 24th November 1914 and recorded in Vol. 26, page 406, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning in the stone 38.0 m. N.
