(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Joe N. Leake all that lot, piece or parcel of land situated, lying and being in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, containing Twenty and Three Quarters (20 3/4) acres or less, having the following meanders and bounds to wit: on waters of Culbana Creek leading to Enoree River on a road leading from Town of Fourhundred Inn to Georgia road about one mile from Ft. Davis adjoining lands of Ed. Bennett, Mr. & Mrs. Robert Bryant and others, being some tract of land conveyed to me by Jim Armstrong, recorded in office of Deed Conveyance of Greenville 27 day September 1916 in Book G, page 23. Beginning at a stone 3' on R. F. West & N. G.
