in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand and DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *Jas. B. Hobby*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto  
the said *Jas. B. Hobby*, all that piece of land lying in  
both sides of Peter's Creek in Greenville Townships,  
County and State aforesaid, being a portion of a tract  
of land described to be by J. T. Fowler on 10th day of  
Nov. 1890, having the following metes and bounds  
to wit: Beginning at a stone on south side of Peter's  
Creek at (R. O. Fowler) corner 3x; thence S. 15° E. 1212'  
thence running in an easterly direction and inter-  
secting the B. Foster on Bridge Road (line) about  
opposite my residence, thence following the B. Foster  
line 7.41 to stone B. Foster gone 3x, thence  
N. 112° 34' W. 1064 to rock 3x; thence S. 47° W. 438, thence S.  
60° W. thence S. 36° W. 11.65 to a stone on north side  
of said creek 3x; thence up the meanderings of
