(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said C. Littlefield

all that certain parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in South Carolina, Greenville County, Chick Springs Township, in the Town of Green, on South side of Emma Street, having the following meter and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on South side of Emma Street, (J. S. Boogier corner) and thence East with said Emma Street 69 feet to C. Littlefield corner on said street; thence nearly South with Littlefield line 209 feet to a stake; thence nearly Westward, 69 feet to J. S. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said A. J. Sullivan, his heirs and assigns, All

of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situated in the State and County aforesaid, in Austin Township, near Bethel Church, adjoining lands of M. P. Brown, A. J.
