(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W.J. Alexander and his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land

situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Grove Township, about nine and a half miles from the City of Greenville, in the fork of the Fork Shoals Road and Log Shoals Road, having the following metes and bounds according to a survey thereof made by the said W.J.
