(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. F. Frye

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in "City View," a suburb west of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds as shown on plat of "Property of W.
