 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto
 the said Nathaw Earle Bright and Annie C. Bright, all that certain
 piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the
 State and County aforesaid, as follows: Beginning at a stone
 of Pewter Studith running with the Dill survey to Post oak
 corner, dead and down or on Frank Balow's corner, thence with
 Balow's line in a North direction far enough to make a corner
 thence parallel with the Dill line back opposite the Studith
 corner to make 17 sevenths acres lying broadside to the Dill
