NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Mrs. Jones McGrorey and Lillian McGrorey, of the City and County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. P. Hillhouse

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said L. P. Hillhouse,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and being known as Lot No. 8 in Block A as shown by plat made Aug. 1917 by R. C. Dalton and recorded in Plat Book 6, page 104, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. This lot with two others was conveyed to us on August 18, 1917, by Lucy L. Hindman and the Deed not being now recorded. This Deed is made subject to the terms and conditions made in the Deed by Mrs. Hindman to us above referred to.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. A. Burns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, being a part of the Riverside Land Company's Land, known as "Riverside" and said lot being designated on a plat made by Carter & Pringle, surveyors, as lot #3 of Block C.C., fronting 50 feet on Colonial Avenue, and having a depth of 125 feet to an alley, and is the same lot of land conveyed to me by Riverside Land Company by deed dated April 2nd, 1912 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 2, Page 85.
