NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, E. A. Westmoreland  
in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred, fifty six and 5/100 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Chainey Littlefield

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Chainey Littlefield, all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land situate in the State and County aforesaid, Chiefly of Springs Township, near the Town of Greer, adjoining lands of Mrs. J. T. Westmoreland, John Burnett, myself, and others, and being a portion of the same land conveyed to me by Jas. Wilson by deed bearing date of October 21st, 1878, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. J. J. at page 92, and having the following metes and bounds courses and distances: Beginning at a stone corner corner of Cemetery lot and run thence S. 89 1/4 E. 8.48 chs. to a cherry tree on Mrs. J. T. Westmoreland's line; thence with the said line N. 17 1/4 W. 7.30 chs. to an iron pin near a large Poplar on J. D. Crain's line; thence N. 81 1/2 W. 86 links to a stone corner, John Burnett's corner; thence N. 78 1/2 W. 6.20 chs. to an iron pin; thence N. 60 W. 2.60 chs. to a stone corner on Burnett's line near a corner; thence S. 2 1/2 W. 9.82 chs. to an iron pin; thence S. 89 1/4 W. 4.08 chs. to the beginning corner, containing eight and nine tenths (8.9) acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Chainey Littlefield and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Chainey Littlefield and his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
