T. M. Ballenger DEED TO J. F. Ayers

NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, T. M. Ballenger of the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and other valuable DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. F. Ayers,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. F. Ayers, all of my right, title and interest & (the same being and undivided one-half interest) in and to all the lot certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, in Ward Two and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the northeast corner of Rawley Street and Park Avenue, and running thence north the northwad line of Park Avenue 377 E. Sixty (60) feet to an iron post, thence N. 20° 45' E. one hundred and seventy-two (172) feet to another iron post, thence north line parallel with Park Avenue N. 77 1/2 W. Sixty (60) feet to an iron post on Rawley Street, thence with the eastern line of Rawley Street S. 20° 45' E. one hundred and seventy-two (172) feet to the beginning corner, and being one-half of the lot of land described in deed of J. F. Ayers to T. M. Ballenger, dated July 26th, 1910, and recorded in Vol. 24, page 150, see also deed of C. C. Jones to J. F. Ayers, dated April 28th, 1910.
