(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. M. Riddle all those certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Greenville Township, about two miles west of the City of Greenville, and being known as lots nos. 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22 of Block "3" of Riverside, plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 323, and being a part of the lots conveyed to me by C. O. Hobbs by his deed dated 28th of November, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 43 at page 28.

W. M. Riddle, his

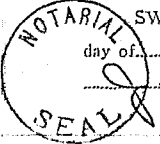
heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
