NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I John Henry Kane, of the
State of New Jersey, in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by John Henry Jamison,
of the State of South Carolina,
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John Henry Jamison, all that piece, parcel
or lot of land situate, lying and being in
ward six of the City of Greenville, on nicholls
and Robinson streets; Beginning at a stake
at the corner of nichols and Robinson streets,
thence along nichols street one hundred feet
to a stake; thence parallel with Robinson
street one hundred feet to a stake; thence
parallel with nichols street one hundred
feet to a stake on Robinson street; thence along
Robinson street one hundred feet to the begin-
ning corner. This is the land conveyed to me
by St. John Co by deed dated December 3rd,
1887, and recorded in R. M. C. Office, Greenville
County in Vol. 35 page 580, on December 5th,
1887, and being described in said deed as
two lots.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

John Henry Jamison, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

John Henry Jamison, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
