in consideration of the sum of Fifty-two hundred and thirty dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

B. B. DeWolfe  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

B. B. DeWolfe, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, more the consent and limit of the Council of said County, on the line of said road, beginning at a point on said road, more the consent of the Council of said County, and running north and north west along said road to the corner, thence along said road to the corner, thence along the line of said road to the corner, thence along the line of said road to the corner, thence along the line of said road to the corner, being more or less as shown to me by S. D. Ellis, on July 13, 1917.
