(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

The Hayler Company: all that certain lot of land
situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near Monaghan Mills, comprising part of lot
#88 of Morgan Hill, the plat of which subdivision
is recorded in a. m. l. Office for Greenville County,
Plat Book "a", page 70, and more particularly described
as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the north
side of Summitt Street, at the southwest corner
of lot #188, as shown on said plat, and running
thence with Summitt Street in an easterly di-
rection forty-five (45) feet to a twenty (20) foot street known
as Langdon Street; thence along the western side of
said Langdon Street in a northerly direction to
a point at right angles to Summitt Street and
which is one hundred and twenty-five (125) feet
from Summitt Street; thence in a westerly direction
along a line parallel with Summitt Street to a
stake on the western line of lot #88; thence with
the western line of lot #88 in a southerly direction
to the beginning corner, being the same lot of
land conveyed to me by D. B. Hayler by deed dated
